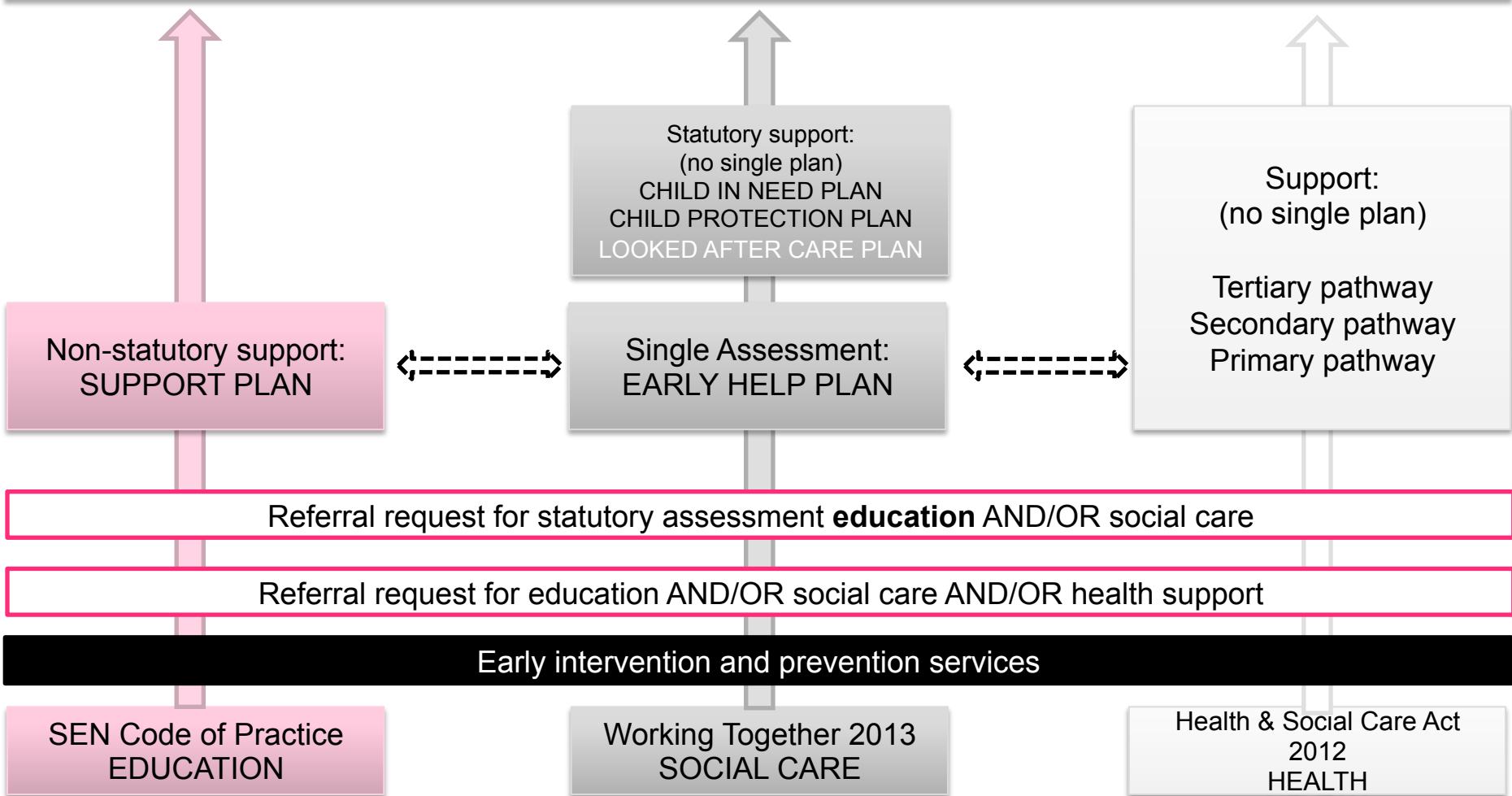


SINGLE EDUCATION HEALTH AND CARE PLAN 0-25



This simple representation of support pathways from early help to a single plan demonstrates:

- The importance of accessibility of early intervention and prevention services
- The pathways in each of the three areas through key thresholds to statutory assessment (or equivalent)
- That a referral for support or statutory assessment can happen at any time but requires a response from all three areas
- That statutory assessment for education is the equivalent of a statement under current legislation
- That there is a need to integrate and co-ordinate 'plans' at the levels below the Single Plan
- That an individual child or young person will not necessarily stay at the highest level of need across all areas from 0-25
